The Registrar of Indigenous Corporations, Anthony Beven, today congratulated the 2010 Indigenous Governance Awards finalists.

Two of them, the Association of Northern, Kimberley and Arnhem Aboriginal Artists Aboriginal Corporation (ANKAAA) and the North Coast Aboriginal Corporation for Community Health, are registered under the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* (CATSI Act), administered by the Registrar of Indigenous Corporations.
